Sun Commons Set to Rise

Abbey Road and Linc Housing, both nonprofit developers of affordable and supportive housing, have partnered to build Sun Commons, a 103-unit large-family affordable and supportive housing development in the North Hollywood neighborhood of Los Angeles. "The real answer to homelessness is homes," said Los Angeles City Councilmember Paul Krekorian. "This very important project will not only provide housing, but provide ongoing services provided by Penny Lane that will really be transformative of lives."

Los Angeles County Supervisor Sheila Kuehl said, "Rising rents are driving far too many people into homelessness. Buildings like the Sun Commons mean that 103 households have the security of a roof over their head and the knowledge that they will never have to move because their landlord raised the rent beyond their means to pay it."

We are proud to be in construction on yet another vital community for the people of Los Angeles. Linc Housing also has an additional 524 apartments currently under development.
